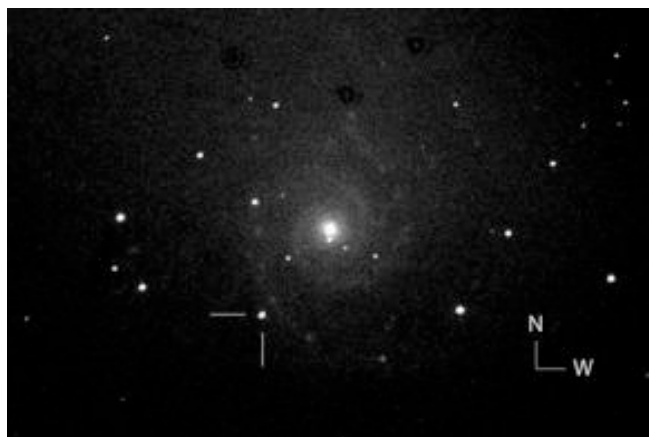

Supernova in M74

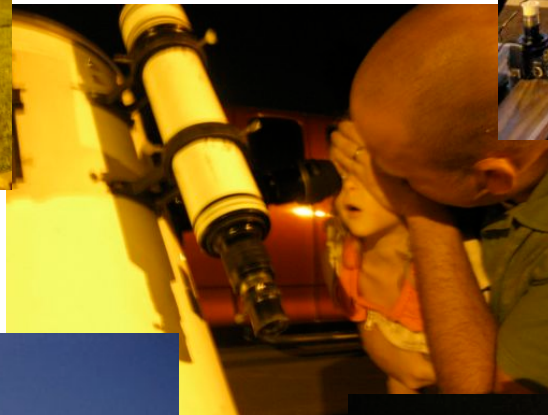
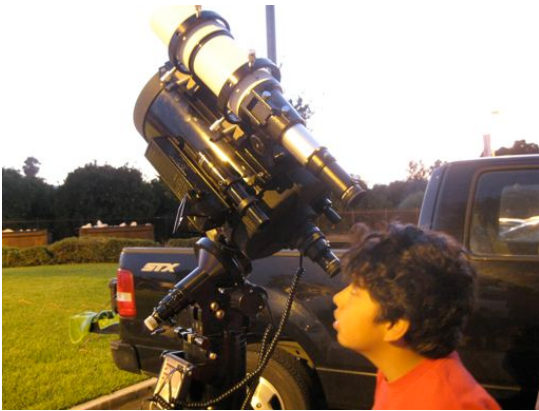

It is apparently a type II (core collapse) event. At mag 12.4 it should be visible in an 8" scope or possibly a smaller scope from a very dark site. All you astro-photographers get your gear out.
